The Local Competition

THE LOCAL COMPETITION HAS THREE COMPONENTS:

Local Entry Form- due 10/13

- 1. Includes basic building information
- 2.\$125 Fee

Written Submission - due by 12:00 pm on 11/26

- 1. Must meet regional criteria
- 2. Entry requirements & judging sheets are available on the BOMA Greater Minn. website

Site inspection from 12/01 - 12/06

- 1. A team of judges will tour your building with you and your engineers
- 2. Each building team may create their own pathways
- 3. The full tour takes about 90 minutes
- 4. Checklists are available on the BOMA Greater Minn. website

LOCAL COMPETITION IS COMPLETED DECEMBER 13, WINNERS ANNOUNCED FEBRUARY 13TH



TOBY Requirements

- BOMA dues-paying member building
- BOMA360 Certified
- 50% of building must be office (except for Industrial, Mixed-use, Medical, & Life Science categories)
- Energy Star benchmarked- no certification necessary (Industrial category exempt)
- Need a 70% score to advance to next level & must pass the site inspection

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need my BOMA360 to compete?

Yes, BOMA Greater Minneapolis requires BOMA360 certifications for local entry. In addition, BOMA360 is required for regional and national entries as well.

Do I need to be a member of BOMA to compete for a TOBY Award?

Yes. The building must be a member—or managed by an entity that is a member—in good standing with both their BOMA local association and BOMA International in order to compete at the regional and/or international levels.

Does my building have to be ENERGY STAR certified to compete?

No, buildings will need to provide ENERGY STAR benchmarking, however, certification is not required

Do all TOBY participants need to compete on the local level, even those that have won Regionals? Yes, all buildings are required to compete on the local level before rising to regionals.



Committee between December 1st- 6th 2024.

The Regional & International Competitions

After winning the local competition:

- changes can be made if necessary until March 20th
- Entries are submitted via BOMA International's online portal (same portal used for local competition) for regional review
 - \$450 entry fee for BOMA Int'l Competition

After winning the regional competition:

- Changes can <u>no longer</u> be made
- Entries are reviewed by international judges








Once you have signed in, click 'Add Building' under the 'Building' drop-down button

If your building already exists in the portal this step is unnecessary




Enter required information and click save




You will be directed to the 'My Buildings' dashboard, this can also be accessed via the 'Buildings" drop-down button


Click 'View TOBY Entries' on the 'Action' drop down button



If your building has not yet been entered click 'Add New TOBY Entry'




If your building has been entered, find it in the dashboard belwo & click 'View/Edit' in the Actions drop down button
